

The Board of Education shall make its own rules and regulations, subject to the provisions of state and national law, and shall organize and maintain a school system as prescribed by these laws as amended. The Board of Education shall act as a general agent of the state in providing public education for the people residing in the district. The Board of Education shall consider itself the agent for establishing and appraising all educational activities within the school district.

Policies of the Board shall be subject to suspension only upon majority vote of the members of the Board present at a meeting in which the proposed suspension has been described in writing, or upon a unanimous vote of all the members of the Board when no such written notice has been given.
