

Based on the belief that the educational program of the Lordsburg Municipal Schools is the concern of all people in the district, and being desirous that such program benefits from the ability, talent, and experience of school patrons, it shall be the policy of the Lordsburg Board of Education to promote and encourage the broadest possible participation by the public in school affairs.

To effectuate this policy in such manner as to accommodate the local citizenry, each regular meeting of the Lordsburg Board of Education shall include an agenda item entitled "Public Forum" which shall be limited to a maximum of thirty minutes duration. Pursuant to procedures established in conjunction with this policy, citizens of the Lordsburg School District shall be afforded the opportunity to address the Board relevant to the district's educational program(s) and/or other areas of operation. The Board will not hear accusations or personal complaints about individuals or personnel of the school system.
