

The school district operates a cafeteria program which provides meals for all students that desire to participate. The cafeteria program is expected to be self-supporting with a minimum of subsidization from the operational budget.

Changes to the prices of meals for participants, both children and adults, are subject to approval by the Board of Education.

Meals may not be charged. If a child forgets to bring his/her money, a written reminder will be sent home or the parents will be contacted by telephone to request payment.

Cafeteria accounts shall be maintained separately from general funds, and cafeteria monies shall be deposited in a commercial bank. Appropriate records shall be maintained for reports to the Public Education Department and to the Board.
