

Professional employees are those whose duties and job responsibilities require, as a minimum, a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university (or the equivalent as determined through Public Education Department regulations and/or state statutes) and the appropriate license issued by the Licensure Unit of the Public Education Department.

Employees of the school district who are considered professional personnel include; classroom instructors, guidance counselors, librarians, nurses, educational diagnosticians, administrators, and related services personnel.

Job descriptions which provide a comprehensive listing of position responsibilities for professional personnel are on file in all administrative offices.
