

The appearance of all employees is considered essential in creating an atmosphere that reflects the high standards students are expected to meet in their behavior and academic endeavors. The appearance of district employees affects the perceptions many local citizens and school visitors have about the quality of educational services to children at a specific school or in the district as a whole.

All employees are expected to dress appropriately, modestly and professionally in line with the setting in which they work and in a manner that reflects the nature of their responsibilities. All employees are expected to serve as positive role models to the children they serve.

Individuals providing purchased services to the district's children are likewise expected to dress appropriately, modestly, and professionally.

Employees, regardless of positions, shall dress in a professional manner while representing the school district away from their normal work stations. All employees are expected to dress according to the appropriateness of the activity for which they are attending and/or participating in when representing the district outside his/her normal work station.

District administrators have the responsibility to encourage and enforce appropriate dress for the staff which they supervise. The use of "common sense" is essential when making decisions relevant to appropriate attire for employees.
