

The Board will usually evaluate the superintendent in December, taking formal action regarding the evaluation and re-employment at the regular January meeting. The Board may, at its discretion, extend the superintendent's contract prior to the year of expiration.

The superintendent shall exercise prudence in determining a re-employment time-frame annually for personnel, considering legislative activity, budgetary implications, and State statute regarding required notices of re-employment. If in possession of adequate information to support planning, he/she shall notify personnel of their re-employment status at least 30 days prior to the end of their individual contracts.
