

A general screening committee consisting of at least three members shall be organized at each school site annually.

Members of the general screening committee shall be appointed by the building administrator during the first week of each school year.

The guidance counselor shall serve on the committee annually.

The purpose of the general screening committee is to carefully review a variety of available data for all students in their respective buildings and to make recommendations for providing the appropriate educational accommodations and assistance for each student in need.

The needs of every enrolled student shall have been thus considered by the general screening committee no later than the end of the first grading period. The general screening committee shall reconvene as needed during the remainder of each school year to determine any need for accommodations and assistance by late-enrolling students.
