

Students may be referred and/or assigned to homebound instruction under one of the following conditions:

- assigned by an Individual Educational Plan Committee (special education students).
- assigned by a Student Assistance Team in the development of a §504 Service Plan, requiring the approval of the superintendent.
- upon recommendation by the principal, made on a case-by-case basis, requiring the approval of the superintendent.

Students on homebound instruction shall receive weekly instruction as designated by the Individual Education Plan, by the §504 Service Plan, or by the principal's recommendation, as relevant.

Students in homebound instruction shall be counted in the average daily membership report at their assigned building.

The principal of the school to which the student is assigned will coordinate services for the student, to include:

- selection and monitoring of instruction
- supervision and compensation of instructional employee
