

Extended Illness means five (5) or more consecutive days of absence due to illness or personal injury.

Students of the Lordsburg Municipal Schools who, due to extended absence caused by personal illness or injury, shall be permitted to make up all work missed, pursuant to the following guidelines:

- **Doctor's confirmation is required, stating reason(s) student is unable to attend school, and the projected period of time he/she will be under medical supervision.**
- **Parent(s) or guardian(s) are to contact the student's school and schedule with the building administrator an appropriate day and time for picking up the assignments.**
- **Building administrators will be responsible for soliciting all student assignments from instructors and having such available for parents. (Day and time as determined in #2)**
- **Assignments will be picked up and returned at least once weekly until the student is able to return to school.**

In the event students are required to be absent for a period of time which may negatively impact their progress toward attainment of sufficient credits for graduation, building administrators may implement alternate strategies in an effort to better accommodate the student.

Students whose absences are classified as "extended" may be eligible for other services. See "Homebound Instruction" policy.
