

Lordsburg Municipal Schools Board of Education recognizes that parents have the obligation and right to be involved in their child's educational process. Furthermore, parents may exempt or opt-out their child from sexual education curriculum which the parent finds to be objectionable.

Schools are required by law to instruct students on abstinence, sexual education curriculum, and behaviors to provide students with appropriate educational knowledge to enable them to make informed decisions.

Lordsburg Schools will have Health Instruction that supports the Standards outlined by the State of New Mexico for the grade levels at which material will be taught.

Parents may opt-out or exempt their child from sexual education curriculum, which the parent finds to be objectionable, within the Health curriculum by submitting a completed Lordsburg Schools Opt-Out and Assurance Document. Students who are exempted will be given alternate assignments and instruction to maintain academic progress. Students will not be disciplined nor lose credit by opting-out of this instruction.
