Test scores are important in providing additional measurement of each student's academic progress, often in comparison with national norms.

Test scores shall be maintained as a part of the student's permanent educational record. Such permanent record shall be released to another school system upon request of the school or parent upon transfer of the student.

Any individual or unauthorized agency outside the school system shall not be permitted to have access to a student's test record without written permission from the parent, or from the student if eighteen (18) years of age.

The parent and student shall have access to the test record of a student under the same parameters as any other component of the student's permanent educational record, excepting the specific testing protocols and content.
