

Adult education programs sponsored by the school district and approved by the Board of Education are permitted provided the programs are well planned, serve a need, and facilities and instructors are available.

Summer programs sponsored by the school district must be approved by the Board of Education. Approved summer programs are an extension of the regular school program and must be planned, financed, and operated in professional manner.

Cooperative agreements between the Lordsburg Municipal School District and outside agencies in providing community services and/or instructional programs must be approved by the Board of Education. The Board of Education's primary responsibility is to provide instructional services and facilities to students who are enrolled in the regular school programs. Therefore, community services cannot be permitted to interfere with this responsibility.
